The Department of Public Safety would like to alert the Saint Paul College community of a burglary and attempted theft that occurred on-campus.

On 08/18/2015 at approximately 12:04 am, a Saint Paul College employee discovered two suspects who were attempting to break-in to an ATM on campus. The suspects immediately fled the campus and were unable to be located by police. It was later discovered that the suspects gained access by breaking out a window on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. The Saint Paul Police Department and campus Public Safety are investigating the theft.

One of the suspects was wearing a hard hat and yellow reflective vest and appeared to be posing as a construction worker. The other male was wearing dark clothing. Both of the suspects had their faces covered by masks. Their identities are unknown at this time.

Public Safety requests assistance with solving and preventing this and other types of crimes that occur on campus.

#### **Crime prevention tips**

- Always lock your office door
- Never leave personal property in plain view in your work area
- Never leave valuables anywhere in your vehicle, including your trunk
- Keep a record of the serial and model numbers of electronics
- Watch for suspicious acting people loitering or lurking in campus buildings and parking lots. Call Public Safety immediately at 651.846.1322 and describe the person's:
  - Gender, race, height, weight, clothing and age.
  - License number (if available) or mode of transportation.
  - Exact location.
- **Do Not** confront or follow people that appear suspicious; contact Public Safety immediately.
- Park in a well-lit area if you expect to return to your car after dark.
- Use the “buddy” system or contact Public Safety for an escort to and from your vehicle
