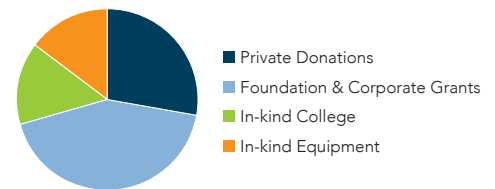
2016 annual report

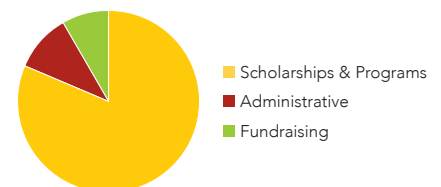
Gifts to the Friends of Saint Paul College are used to provide scholarships for students and fund innovative new programs. While we strive to keep the cost of education affordable, many students need additional assistance. Scholarships can lessen the burden.

In 2015-16, the Foundation awarded \$300,000 in scholarships to 250 students. Over 500 community members attended special events on campus to support student success. We appreciate all of the support we receive from individuals in the community and from our business and industry partners.

- **\$300,000** in scholarships awarded to **250** students
- **\$10,000** in emergency grants helped **40** students stay on track in spite of unexpected financial emergencies
- **70%** of Saint Paul College employees donated nearly **\$35,000** to fund scholarships and other programs for our students
- Over **2,000** Saint Paul College students gained additional support through new programs funded by foundation, corporate and government grants
- **580** high school students were engaged in college readiness activities at Saint Paul College with funding from foundation, corporate and government grants
- **100%** of Friends of Saint Paul College Board members donated over \$35,000
