responsibilities

- » Members are elected to a three-year term and can serve an optional second term.
- » Responsibilities include governance and fundraising assignments.
- » Members are encouraged to give in an amount that is personally meaningful to maintain a 100% board-giving goal.
- » The full board meets four times annually, and each member's chosen subcommittee meets four times. 75% combined attendance is expected. Meetings are held either in-person or fully online.
- » An in-person retreat is held in each year in late August.
- » Board members advocate for student needs within the community as well within their personal and professional networks.
- » Our annual benefit event, Friends on the Lawn, along with our scholarship receptions and other College events, provide inspiration and engagement, making service on our board particularly rewarding and motivating.
