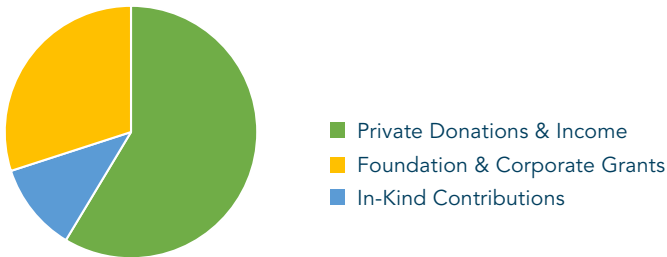

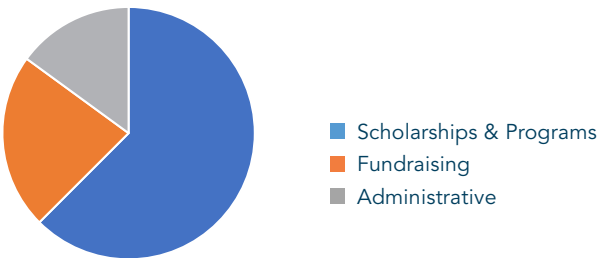

Over **\$301,000** in scholarships were awarded to students across the College.

Almost **\$99,000** in emergency student grants given for unexpected needs like car repairs, utility bills, childcare and food.

Endowed scholarships grew to **\$1,855,000** during the 2019-2020 school year. Funds are held at the Saint Paul & Minnesota Foundation.

The new Tools/Books/Supplies fund distributed more than **\$87,000** to equip students with workshop, lab, and classroom materials.
