

PSEO Courses for Sophomores

High school Sophomores may be eligible to participate in PSEO and enroll in one Career and Technical Education (CTE) course if they have attained college-level Reading and Writing placement through passing score on the Reading portion of the 8th grade Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment (MCA) or other approved methods. In addition, Sophomores must meet the Saint Paul College PSEO admissions requirements and course admission requirements. If a sophomore receives a grade of C or better in the CTE course, the student is allowed to take the same number and variety of courses that are available to Junior and Seniors in the subsequent term.

Students must meet course specific pre-requisite(s) prior to registration. Enrollment in courses subject to space availability and not all courses are offered each semester. Please see the online Course Schedule to determine term course offerings.
